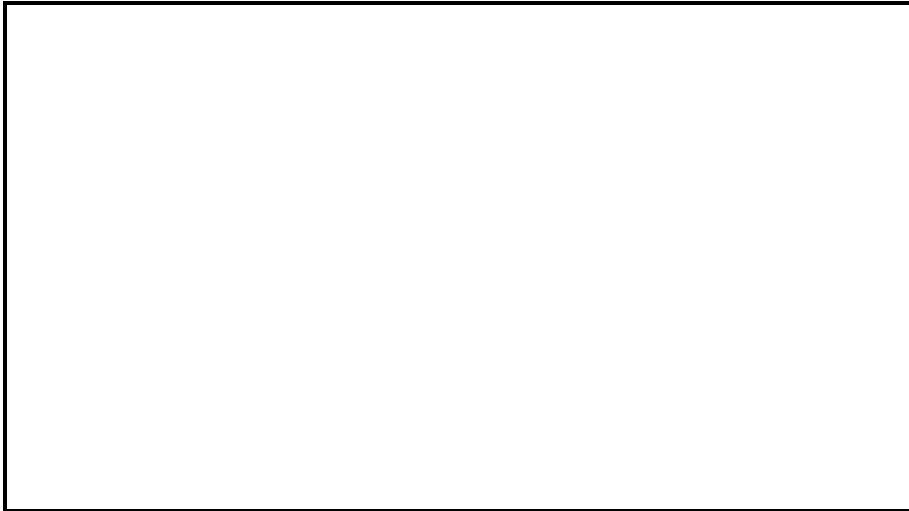


## Sermon Notes
