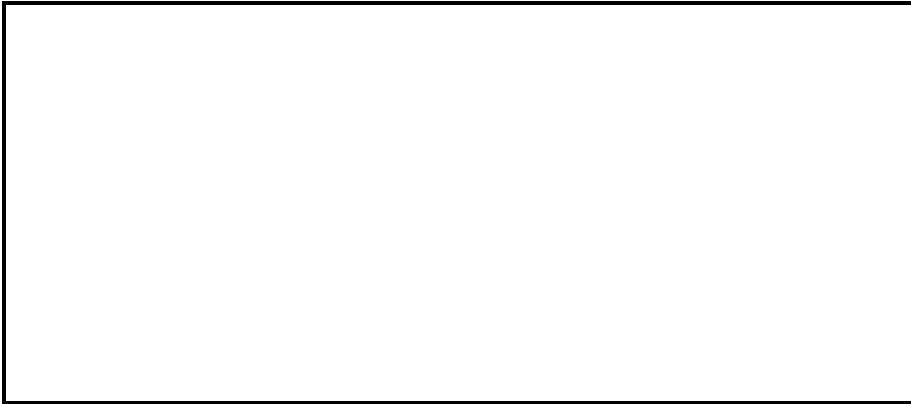

January 1, 1958 – Trustees propose purchase of the Tedrow School and the costs to move the church and attach it to the school. A 2/3 majority vote was needed. The vote passed by a very large majority to purchase the school. At the same meeting it was decided to discontinue the radio program on WONW to help get the treasury out of the red.
